

Commercial Carpet Maintenance

Proper care will help protect and maintain the appearance and performance of your flooring. A care program consists of these key areas:



Vacuum

Vacuuming is the most important step in your maintenance program. Vacuum daily.



Spot Clean

Spray mist neutral pH carpet cleaner on a stain/soil spot and blot with a towel. Promptly use spotting brush to agitate the neutral pH cleaner and remove any matter from the spot.



Encapsulation

Vacuum first. Spray encapsulation cleaner on the carpet, then use the counter rotating brush (CRB) to encapsulate the soil. Vacuum after 15 minutes of dry time.



Hot Water Extraction

Vacuum first. Pre-spray traffic lane cleaner on the carpet. Agitate with CRB, then extract with hot water.

Did You Know?

80% of soil brought into a facility can be trapped within 6 to 8 steps onto a carpeted surface. Entry mats or walk-off tile will reduce necessary maintenance for both carpet and resilient flooring.

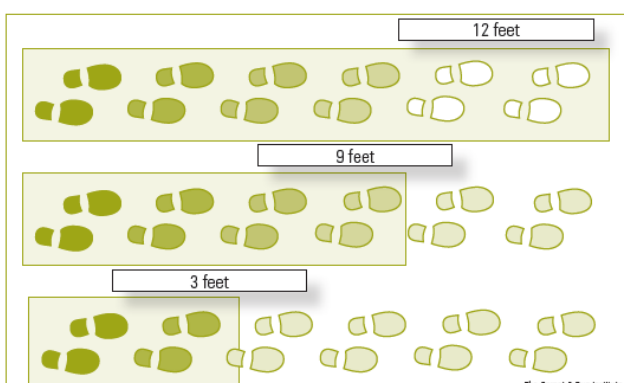
